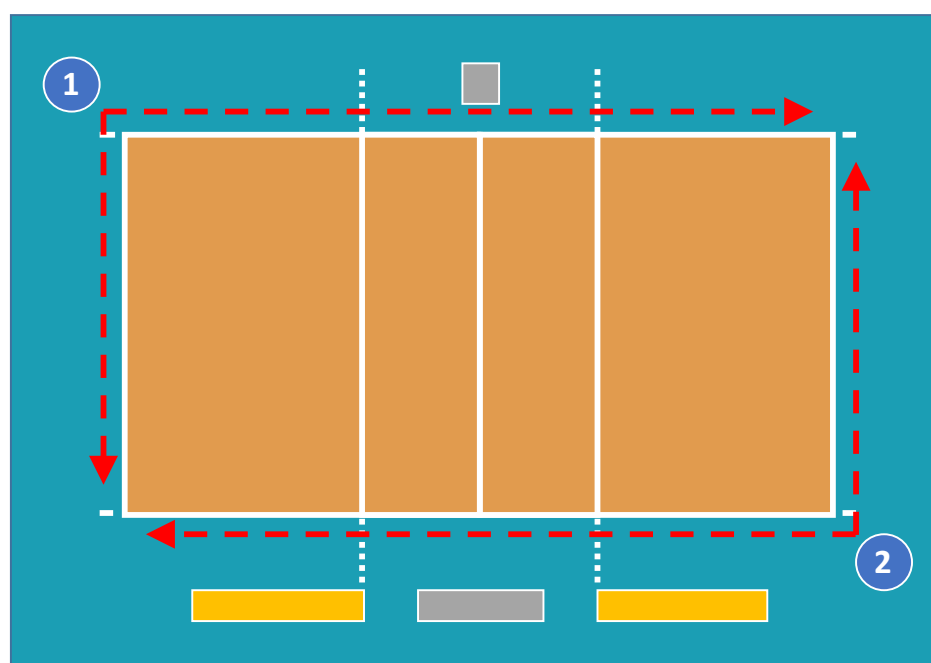


Line Judge Requirements

It was agreed at the 2015 Volleyball New Zealand Forum that from 2016, duty teams at VNZ events (Senior Secondary School Championships, Club Championships, NI/SI Junior Championships) would only have to provide two line judges instead of four.

The FIVB rule book states for 2 line judges:

- They stand at the corners of the court closest to the right hand of each referee, diagonally at 1 to 2 m from the corner.
- Each one of them controls both the end line and side line on his/her side.



Advantages:

- Requires less people for duty
- More opportunities to sub line judges between sets
